The Florida Legislature has enacted section 44.106, Florida Statutes, to provide for standards and procedures of those persons who are eligible and qualified to serve as arbitrators. Rules 11.010 through 11.130, Fla. R. Arb. establish qualifications and standards of professional conduct for those individuals who are interested in serving as arbitrators. Rule 1.810(a), Fla.R.Civ.P. requires the chief judge to maintain a list of individuals who are determined eligible and qualified to act as arbitrators;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

- 1. The Alternative Dispute Resolution Office shall maintain a list of those individuals who have provided evidence that they have met the qualifications set forth in the applicable rules, and have agreed to serve as arbitrators,
- 2. Those individuals listed with the Alternative Dispute Resolution Office and those added hereafter by addendum, are determined to be eligible and qualified to serve as arbitrators in the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida with all the power and duties conferred by Chapter 44, Florida Statutes and Rules 1.700, 1.810-1.830, Florida Rules of Civil Procedure.
- 3. This order shall take effect as of the date hereon and continue until revoked by subsequent order of this Court.
