IN RE: INACTIVE TRAFFIC CITATIONS
OF **DECEASED DEFENDANTS**

The Judges of the County Court of Palm Beach County, Florida, have determined that the following is necessary and proper for the disposition of traffic cases.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rules of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

The Clerk **and Comptroller's Office** is ordered to dismiss any citation and satisfy any D-6 issued to anyone who is deceased. Proof of death shall consist of an official death certificate or any official notification of death by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles or the Department of Health (Vital Statistics). If any of these cases have an outstanding or unsatisfied D-6 and/or any unpaid fines/costs, the Clerk, pursuant to Florida Rule of Traffic Court 6.575, shall vacate same.
