IN RE: FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH DRIVERS
IMPROVEMENT SCHOOL ELECTIONS.

:
NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. That in those cases where the individual cited has previously elected to attend, either a 4 hour or 8 hour driver improvement course, and has subsequently failed to successfully complete the necessary course within 90 days, the Clerk shall do the following:
 - a. **refer the case to the Administrative Traffic Hearing Officer or any other person designated by the Chief Judge for entry of an order adjudicating the defendant guilty of the infraction charged; and**
 - b. **notify the Department of the failure to comply; and**
 - c. **collect all outstanding statutory civil penalties, late fees, reinstatement fees, deferral fees and reset fees, if applicable.**
2. The provisions in this order shall supersede any previous orders or memoranda directed toward any of the matters contained herein, and any such previous orders or memoranda in conflict herewith are rescinded.
