
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 11.103-12/12*

IN RE: JUDICIAL SENIORITY
_____:

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. Seniority among judges in the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit shall be determined by the length of time that a person has served as a judge, **whether or not continuous**, on any court of the State of Florida.
2. If a judge has served on one court throughout his or her tenure, the length of time in service will determine the judge's seniority. If, however, the judge has served on more than one state court, the judge's seniority will be determined by adding the years of service on all state courts.
3. If two or more judges have served the same length of time, the judge who has served more years as a circuit judge in the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit shall have seniority.
