
IN RE: TRANSFER OF CASES FROM
COUNTY COURT TO CIRCUIT COURT

Amended claims, counter claims, cross claims and third party claims filed in county civil court matters may necessitate the transfer of the original county court claim to circuit civil court. The upfiling of misdemeanor charges to felony charges may occur while a defendant is before a county criminal court judge.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. Procedures for the transfer of county civil cases to circuit civil is set forth in Administrative Order 3.104 9/08 (as amended).
2. Procedures for the setting of bond when a misdemeanor charge is upfiled to a felony is set forth in Administrative Order 4.101 9/08 as amended.
