Access to case law and legal treatises is essential to the discharge of the court's constitutional responsibilities.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. A bench library containing the following volumes shall be established in every courtroom and shall remain in the courtroom upon rotation of the divisional judge:

Florida Statutes
Florida Rules of Court-State
Florida Standard Jury Instructions in Criminal Cases (Criminal Judges)
Florida Standard Jury Instructions in Civil Cases (Civil Judges)

- 2. There shall be a court law library in the Main Courthouse, South County Courthouse, and North County Courthouse.
- 3. Each court law library will have available paper subscriptions to the Florida Law Weekly, Florida Law Weekly Supplement, and the Florida Law Weekly Federal for use by the public and the judiciary.
- 4. An electronic edition of Florida Law Weekly, Florida Law Weekly Supplement, and the Florida Law Weekly Federal is available for use by the judiciary and court staff.
- 5. Any request by a judge for additional research resources must be in writing and approved by the Chief Judge and limited to \$400 per judge each fiscal year.
- 6. All judicial libraries shall be maintained by the law library staff.
