A court website can provide information that can assist both the public and members of the bar.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. All materials posted must be related to court business.
2. **All materials to be posted on the website must be reviewed and approved by the Chief Judge, the Court Administrator, or their authorized designee.**
3. **To post information on the website, the information must be submitted to Court Technology. Requests outside the established scope of content on the website must be submitted to the Court Administrator or a designee for approval prior to publication. The exception to this rule is calendar - related information, or other approved divisional information posted directly by a judge or judicial assistant on their divisional website.**
4. **For case related information, such as signed orders to be posted on the website, the link will list the case name, case number and the title of the document being posted (i.e. Smith v. Jones -2008-000123 "AN"- Order on Motion for Summary Judgment).**
