IN RE: ORDER TEMPORARILY ASSIGNING
THE HONORABLE **ASHLEY ZUCKERMAN**
AS AN ACTING CIRCUIT JUDGE

It is necessary for the orderly and prompt dispatch of cases within the jurisdiction of the Circuit Court that a County Court Judge be assigned to temporary duty as a Circuit Judge. Administrative Order 11.110-3/17 currently authorizes a County Court Judge to serve as a Circuit Judge.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. The Honorable **Ashley Zuckerman**, Judge of the County Court in and for Palm Beach County, Florida, was assigned effective September 21, 2020, to temporarily serve as a Circuit Judge for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida for purposes of reviewing, hearing, and determining matters pending in **Division FC**.
2. Judge **Ashley Zuckerman** is vested with all and singular powers and prerogatives conferred by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida upon a Circuit Judge.
3. This order shall remain in full force and effect for six months from **September 16, 2022**.
