ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 12-12.502-3/12

IN RE: PUBLICATION OF NON-CONFIDENTIAL RECORDS IN A CASE OF SIGNIFICANT PUBLIC INTEREST

Supreme Court Administrative Order 07-49 permits the Chief Judge to direct that all non-confidential records in a case be made available electronically when the case is of significant public interest. Although it is not the prerogative of this Court to determine which pending case or cases could be considered of great public interest, the case of <a href="State v. Goodman">State v. Goodman</a>, 2010CF005829AXXMB has been deemed to be a Special Interest/High Profile case pursuant to Fifteenth Judicial Circuit Administrative Order 2.208-2/09. Consequently and pursuant to the aforesaid Fifteenth Circuit Administrative Order, both a Media Committee and a High Profile Committee have been created to assist with the public dissemination of information in relation to the <a href="State v. Goodman">State v. Goodman</a> case. To assist these committees in responding to the increased demand for public information in connection with this case, it does appear that it would ease the burden of providing public records to interested persons by having such public records available in an electronic fashion.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

When so requested by the trial judge in the case of <u>State v. Goodman</u>, the Clerk of Court shall make available on its website public records/court pleadings in case number 2010CF005829AXXMB.
