
IN RE: ADDITIONAL COURT HOLIDAYS

The State Courts System Personnel Rules and Regulations **4.07 (3)** permits the chief judge to designate Good Friday, Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur as **additional** legal holidays. It would be an appropriate sign of respect and religious tolerance to cancel court activities in Palm Beach County on Good Friday, Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur so that litigants, court personnel and attorneys may observe these important holy days.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. All court activities, including judicial and public sales, in Palm Beach County are suspended on Good Friday, Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. These days shall be recognized holidays for all judicial offices.
2. Nothing in this Order shall conflict with First Appearance scheduling.
