Pursuant to Rule 2.215(b), Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, the Chief Judge exercises administrative supervision over all the courts in the circuit. Local Rule I was approved by the Florida Supreme Court on June 1, 1999, Local Rule 1 established the divisions of the Circuit and County Courts of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit. Local Rule 1 was vacated by Administrative Order 12.014.

**NOW THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority conferred by the Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. Five divisions of the Circuit Court are created for the administration and management of court proceedings.
  1. Appellate Division
  2. Civil Division
  3. Criminal Division (includes Veterans' Court Division, Competency Division, and Drug Court Division)
  4. Unified Family Court Division (includes Juvenile Dependency and Juvenile Delinquency Division)
  5. Probate & Guardianship Division (includes Risk Protection Order Division)
2. Two divisions of the County Court for Palm Beach County are created for the administration and management of court proceedings.
  1. Civil Division (includes Wage Dispute Division)

2. Criminal Division (includes DUS Division, Competency Division, and BUI Division)
3. Two divisions of the Circuit and County Court for Palm Beach County are created for the administration and management of court proceedings of the Circuit Court and County Court.
  1. Domestic Violence Division
  2. Trial Division
