OF BIO-HAZARDOUS/INFECTIOUS WASTE



To ensure the safe collection and disposal of bio-hazardous /infectious waste material(s) which may be introduced during courtroom proceedings, Palm Beach County has set forth policies and procedures for waste containment and removal **which are also consistent with Administrative Order No. 2.203-9/08 (as amended).**

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. In those instances when a court proceeding may require the containment and removal of bio-hazardous/infectious waste material or any material perceived to be a health risk, the bailiff assigned to that proceeding shall immediately contact Palm Beach County Facilities Management at 355-2255. Custodial services shall deliver immediately a special waste receptacle for disposal of such materials when appropriate or necessary, the bailiff shall notify PBC Facilities to remove the waste receptacle or when a replacement is needed.
2. Palm Beach County Facilities will be responsible for disposing the waste by a certified waste disposal provider on contract with Palm Beach County.
