IN RE: CASE ADVANCEMENT IN
NON-CRIMINAL MATTERS

Pursuant to Rule of Judicial Administration 2.545(c), in any non-criminal action, assigned a priority status by statute, rule of procedure, case law or otherwise, if a party is of the good faith opinion that the case has not been properly advanced on the docket or has not received priority in scheduling consistent with its priority case status, after having filed the notices required by Rule 2.545(c)(1), then the party may seek review of such action by motion.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

A party who files a motion regarding advancement of a non criminal matter shall direct the motion to the administrative judge of that division of the court unless it is that particular administrative judge before whom the case is currently pending. In that event the motion shall be directed to the chief judge.
