ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 3.106 - 11/14

IN RE: CORRECTING SCRIVENER'S ERRORS
IN CIRCUIT AND COUNTY CIVIL CASES

Tanner v. State, 744 So.2d 101722 (Fla. 4th DCA 1997) finds that the Clerk of Court may not refuse to accept documents which contain scrivener's errors in the caption. To ensure accurate court records and the timely administration of justice, corrections to scrivener errors must be addressed.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

The Clerk and Comptroller's Office shall correct scrivener errors in the caption or case number of a civil court filing so that the filing can be docketed in the correct court file.
