
IN RE: RECALL OF CAPIASES IN
NOLLE PROSSED CASES

The court may direct the clerk to issue a *capias* for a defendant's arrest if the defendant fails to appear in court (Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.730 and Florida Rule of Traffic Court 6.190). *Capiases* may remain active in closed cases, which have been nolle prossed by the State without a court hearing or dismissed because of an inactive status pursuant to Administrative Order 4.605-9/08 (as amended).

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. *Capiases* are hereby recalled on **felony**, misdemeanor and traffic crimes that have been nolle prossed by the State without a court hearing or that have been dismissed because of inactive status pursuant to an Administrative Order 4.605-9/08 (as amended).
2. The clerk is authorized to take appropriate steps to implement this order.
