The court may direct the clerk to issue a capias for a defendant's arrest if the defendant fails to appear in court (Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.730 and Florida Rule of Traffic Court 6.190). Capiases may remain active in closed cases, which have been nolle prossed by the State without a court hearing or dismissed because of an inactive status pursuant to Administrative Order 4.605-9/08 (as amended).

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

- 1. Capiases are hereby recalled on **felony**, misdemeanor and traffic crimes that have been nolle prossed by the State without a court hearing or that have been dismissed because of inactive status pursuant to an Administrative Order 4.605-9/08 (as amended).
- 2. The clerk is authorized to take appropriate steps to implement this order.
