
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 4.407 - 9/08*

IN RE: DISTRIBUTION OF UNCLAIMED RESTITUTION

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. When restitution is ordered by the Court and is subsequently collected by the Clerk's Office or PRIDE, and the victim who is to receive this court ordered restitution is unable to be located, these funds shall be disbursed to the Crimes Compensation Trust Fund of the Office of the Attorney General, Division of Victim Services, Department of Legal Affairs, The Capitol, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1050.
2. Such disbursement should clearly designate these funds as Unclaimed Restitution because of the unknown whereabouts of the victims.
3. Should this victim later be located or come forward, they may claim any funds paid on their behalf by sending a **notarized** written request to the Crimes Compensation Trust Fund.
