Administrative Order Number 5.108-2/09 (as amended) establishes the office of Unified Family Court Magistrate. Magistrates schedule and conduct post final judgment enforcement proceedings and make findings of facts, conclusions of law and recommendations pursuant to Rules 1.490, Fla.R.Civ.P. and 12.491, Fla.Fam.L.R.P. Post judgment enforcement motions in Title IV cases must be promptly ruled upon.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. General Magistrates shall ensure that proposed recommended orders are promptly submitted to the appropriate circuit judge.
2. General Magistrates shall ensure that agreed or proposed recommended orders received from the parties, if approved, are submitted to the appropriate circuit judge within 3 working days of receipt by the general magistrate.
3. General Magistrates shall conduct commitment hearings on motions for commitment filed in Title IV cases within six (6) weeks of the motion being filed with the clerk of court.
4. General Magistrates shall submit their reports and proposed orders on Title IV motions for commitment to the circuit court judge within one (1) week of the commitment hearing.
