IN RE:	FILING OF CERTIFICATES OF LIVE BIRTH
	IN FAMILY LAW CASES

Chapter 68.07, Florida Statues, allows the parents of a minor child to file a Petition for Change of Name. Chapter 751, Florida Statues, allows for the filing of a Petition for Temporary Custody by Extended Family Members and a Petition for Concurrent Custody. Chapter 742, Florida Statues, allows the mother of a child or the putative father of a child to file a Petition to Determine Paternity. The Court often deems necessary to review the Certificate of Live Birth of the minor child(ren) to make a determination and appropriate decision in these cases.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

- 1. In the interest of the judicial economy and to increase the efficiency in processing time of these cases, the Court is mandating the filing of a Live Birth Certificate for any minor child(ren) involved in any Petition for Change of Name for a Minor, Petition for Temporary Custody by Extended Family Members, Petition for Concurrent Custody and Petition to Determine Paternity.
- 2. The Petitioner or Petitioner's attorney shall file a copy of the Live Birth Certificate for any minor child(ren) involved in these cases at the time of initiating the case.
- 3. In a Petition to Determine Paternity, wherein the Mother is the Respondent, the Mother or Mother's attorney shall file a copy of the Live Birth Certificate for the minor child(ren) involved in the case upon filing of an Answer.
- 4. The original Live Birth Certificate document will not be required unless specifically requested by the Court.
- 5. Pursuant to Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, Rule 2.425 any filed Live Birth Certificate for the minor child(ren) shall be deemed confidential.
