CIVIL DIVISION "AH" EXHIBIT REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL NON-JURY MATTERS

- 1. <u>All exhibits</u> must be clearly **marked before the trial or hearing is set to begin**. Exhibits shall be marked by a **numbered sticker** on the top right-hand corner of the front of each exhibit clearly identifying the **case number** and party who is offering the exhibit, e.g., Plaintiff or Defendant; Petitioner or Respondent.
- 2. An **exhibit list** shall be provided to the Court at the start of the trial or hearing and <u>must</u> be numbered chronologically.
- 3. All composite exhibits should be designated by number and letter: *i.e.*, 1a, 1b, 1c, etc.
- 4. Exhibit lists which state "all", "any" and "any and all" shall not be accepted.
- 5. Loose photographs shall NOT be accepted. Photos <u>MUST</u> be individually marked and mounted. No clips or rubber bands.
- 6. Exhibits <u>MUST BE</u> bound: *i.e., s*taples, binders, acco-type fasteners, etc.
- 7. Large demonstrative boards <u>MUST</u> be accompanied by a smaller version. The large boards will be returned at the end of the case/hearing and the smaller versions substituted to be placed in the evidence vault.
