It is the intent of this Court to dispose of the subject matter of the specially set motion on the date and time appearing on the notice. Accordingly, counsel must either: (1) be present personally or by telephone conference call at the hearing (telephone appearance must be approved in advance); or (2) submit an agreed order disposing of the motion.

All memoranda, **not to exceed ten double spaced pages without Court approval**, with case authority shall be delivered to the first floor information desk or mailed so as to be received **seven (7) days in advance of the hearing and should designate the date and time of the hearing which they reference**. The moving party shall have at the time of the hearing a blank proposed order with self-addressed stamped envelopes. Arguments shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes per side or less as the Court deems appropriate. No motion which has not been specifically scheduled with the Judicial Assistant will be heard at the time of hearing.
