AMENDED STANDING ORDER REGARDING DEFENDANTS NOT TO BE TRANSPORTED FOR CALENDAR CALLS, CASE DISPOSITION HEARINGS, OR STATUS CHECKS

Based on the current pandemic, the Florida Supreme Court's Administrative Orders related thereto, and the 15th Circuit's Administrative Order 12.510, the Court amends its prior standing order to include **no transport on calendar calls as a non-essential hearing.** This in no way precludes defense counsel from arranging remote appearances for Defendants for any hearing.

The Sheriff of Palm Beach County is directed to **NOT TRANSPORT** defendants set for **CALENDAR CALL OR ANY PRE-TRIAL CONFERENCE**, Case Disposition Hearing, Status Check or Initial Case Conference (ICC) hearings in Division "V" without a court order to Transport.

The Sheriff of Palm Beach County is directed **TO TRANSPORT** Defendants for motions and evidentiary hearings, Trial, Preliminary and Final Violation of Probation Hearings, Plea Conferences, and Bond hearings without a prior court order.
