## PER CURIAM.

After our independent review of the record, we affirm the appellant's judgment and sentence. See Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). However, we remand the case to the county court with instructions to either locate the original order of probation or to enter an order of probation nunc pro tunc July 31, 2012 that conforms to the court's oral pronouncement. Appellant need not be present. See Walker v. State, 686 So. 2d 758 (Fla. 1st DCA 1997).
