## PER CURIAM.

The Petition for Writ of Certiorari is DISMISSED as moot. Notwithstanding our dismissal, the Respondent is reminded that the failure to issue subpoenas to officers and witnesses identified in any documentary evidence submitted at or prior to the hearing shall result in an order quashing the findings of the hearing officer. Lee v. DHSMV, 4 So. 3d 754, 758 (Fla. 1st DCA 2009); Yankey v. DHSMV, 6 So. 3d 633, 638 (Fla. 2d DCA 2009); De Jong v. DHSMV, 17 Fla. L. Weekly Supp. 90c (Fla. 15th Jud. Cir. 2009); Sexton v. DHSMV, 16 Fla. L. Weekly Supp. 726a (Fla. 15th Jud. Cir. 2009); Johnson v. DHSMV, 16 Fla. L. Weekly Supp. 400a (Fla. 15th Jud. Cir. 2009). Moreover, arbitrarily limiting a party's cross examination is a denial of due process. Petitioner's Motion for Attorney's Fees and Costs is DENIED.
