Phase	Court Appearance	Requirements	Expected Duration
I	Every 2 weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Development of treatment plan and assessment of family needs ● Individual/group/family sessions as recommended by provider (1-3 sessions/week) ● Random drug testing, 1 time per week ● Complete written educational/employment plan ● Abide by court-ordered curfew and household rules ● Identification of pro-social activity ● Weekly check in with Drug Court Case Manager ● Work towards completion of victim and restitution sanctions ● Work with DDC Case Manager and parent/advocate to obtain FL Identification card 	30 days
ACCLIMATION			
II	Every 2 weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Individual/group/family sessions as recommended by provider (1-3 sessions/week) ● Random drug testing, 2-3 times per week ● Evolving educational/employment plan with measurable objectives ● Weekly check in with Drug Court Case Manager ● Abide by court-ordered curfew and household rules - based on progress ● Participation in pro-social activity as chosen by youth, approved by team ● Implement family activity ● Continuation of victim and restitution sanctions 	60 days of clean drug testing
INTENSIVE SERVICES			
III	Every 2 weeks*	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Individual/group/family sessions as recommended by provider (1-3 sessions/week) ● Random drug testing, 2-3 times per week ● Completion of educational/employment plan goals ● Abide by court-ordered curfew and household rules - based on progress ● Create and present discharge plan - include vision board and written reflection ● Continuation of victim and restitution sanctions ● Participation in a pro-social activity ● Weekly check in with Drug Court Case Manager 	90 days of clean drug testing
